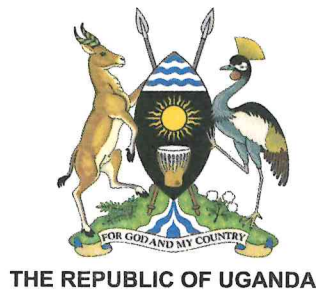

**RE: RESCHEDULING OF DIGITAL GOVERNMENT AFRICA
SUMMIT UGANDA TO 2ND - 4TH FEBRUARY 2027**

On behalf of the Government of the Republic of Uganda, and under the leadership of the Ministry of ICT and National Guidance, we write to confirm the rescheduling of the Digital Government Africa Summit, originally scheduled to take place in Kampala from 6th - 8th October 2026.

Following careful consultation with the relevant Government authorities, participating institutions, international partners and the organisers, the Summit will now take place at the Speke Resort & Convention Centre, Uganda, from **2nd - 4th February 2027**. This decision has been taken in the best interests of all delegates, participating governments, international organisations, development and industry partners.

While Uganda has fully contained the Ebola situation, with no new infections recorded since 5th June 2026, the Government recognises that a number of countries continue to maintain travel advisories or temporary travel restrictions linked to the recognised incubation and monitoring periods for the virus.

The Government of Uganda has extensive experience in managing public health situations and maintains a well-organised healthcare system that prioritises the safety and wellbeing of citizens, visitors and international guests. Uganda has repeatedly demonstrated its ability to respond

effectively to health emergencies through coordinated surveillance, public health leadership and collaboration with local regional and international health partners.

The decision to reschedule the Digital Government Africa Summit is therefore a responsible measure, designed to ensure that the event proceeds securely with the highest possible level of international participation, confidence and success.

The Government of Uganda reaffirms its full commitment to hosting the Digital Government Africa Summit under the patronage and leadership of the Ministry of ICT and National Guidance. The Summit continues to have the full endorsement of the Cabinet of the Republic of Uganda, together with the support and participation of key Government institutions, including the Office of the President, the Ministry of Internal Affairs, and the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development.

As previously confirmed, the National Information Technology Authority – Uganda (NITA-U) will continue to play a pivotal role of coordinating the Summit activities under the Ministry of ICT and National Guidance.

All current registrations for the Digital Government Africa Summit will automatically be carried forward to the new dates of **2nd – 4th February 2027**. The Government of Uganda will also be re-issuing official invitations to African Ministers responsible for ICT, Digital Economy, Internal Affairs, Home Affairs, Finance, and related national e-government and digital transformation agencies.

The purpose of the Digital Government Africa Summit remains to bring African governments together with leading industry partners, investors and solution providers to accelerate the delivery of digital government infrastructure, digital public services, digital identity, cybersecurity, cloud services, artificial intelligence, electronic payments, data systems and integrated management platforms.

Uganda is proud to host this important high-level, meetings-based Summit and looks forward to welcoming ministers, senior government officials, development partners and technology leaders from across Africa and the world.

We wish to express our appreciation to all registered delegates, sponsors, partners and participating governments for their understanding and cooperation. The revised dates provide the strongest opportunity to deliver an outstanding Summit with the broad international participation that this important pan-African forum deserves.
